The MI GreenPower program is certified by Green-e® Energy. As part of this certification, we are required to provide you with detailed information about the product, including this Product Content Label and the program's Price, Terms and Conditions.

When you enroll in MI GreenPower, you purchase renewable energy equal to your chosen percentage of your monthly kilowatt-hour (kWh) electricity usage, in 5% increments up to 100%. The product is comprised of the following new renewable resources averaged annually.

How will I be billed?	Your MI GreenPower purchase is month-to-month and will be listed on your DTE Energy bill. This charge is in addition to your regular electricity bill and will fluctuate based on the amount of electricity used.
What is the rate?	The MI GreenPower program is a premium product that includes a subscription rate of 7.2 cents per kWh that will remain the same for the life of the program, and a credit based on the value and capacity of the energy produced in proportion to your subscription level. In 2019, your credit will be 3.9 cents per kWh (a net cost of 3.3 cents). This product is billed based on specified percentage of electricity use.
Will the rate change over time?	The subscription cost will remain fixed. The credit will be recalculated annually. We will notify you of a rate change in advance.
Can I cancel my participation?	Yes. You may cancel your participation in MI GreenPower at any time. To cancel, please call <b>855.613.4445</b> .
Will I be subject to any additional fees?	No other fees apply
